

## **THE MASTERS SCHOOL UNIFORMS/EQUIPMENT FOR DANCE**

### **P.E. Dance and Dance Technique I**

Female dance students are required to wear a black, scoop neck, long-sleeved, short-sleeved or tank leotard with black stirrup or transition (converts from footed to footless) tights for **jazz and modern classes**, and pink-footed or transition tights for **ballet class**. Each of these items is available for purchase through the department. Students preferring cotton or cotton-blend dance-wear are encouraged to bring these from home. Students may wear jazz shoes for jazz class (not a requirement), and students must provide these from home. Male dance students are required to wear the Masters t-shirt and sweatpants; white socks are also required.

Students must wear pink, white (preferred colors) or black ballet shoes for ballet class; some ballet shoes are available for rental from the department at a minimal fee.

### **Dance History, Theory, and Technique II and III**

Female dance students may wear any DARK COLORED leotard of their choice. Black scoop neck, long-sleeved leotards are available for purchase through the department. Pink footed or transition tights (converts from footed to footless) must be worn for ballet; black stirrup or transition tights for modern, jazz and tap classes. Tights are available for purchase through the department. Male dance students are required to wear a white t-shirt and black men's tights; white socks are also required. All students in this year-long, more advanced dance minor class are required to have all appropriate footwear: i.e., ballet shoes (pink or white for women; white or black for men), jazz shoes and tap shoes. All shoes must be provided from home. Leg warmers (any color) and ballet skirts (any color) are allowed but not required.
