

THE MASTERS SCHOOL CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS AND SUGGESTIONS

Clothing: During the academic day, students must adhere to the school dress code and be neat, clean, and appropriate to an educational environment: no blue jeans, fatigues, work pants, tee shirts, obvious athletic apparel, midriff blouses, halter tops, or tops with string straps. Boys must wear shirts with collars.

Blue jeans may be worn only after the academic day is over (3:00 p.m.) and on weekends, except for Heads dinners (more formal dinners) and other special events that will be listed on the monthly calendar. For these special events, boys will need a jacket, shirt, tie, dress slacks (khakis or corduroys), shoes (not sneakers), and girls will need a dress, skirt, and blouse (or dressy pants), and shoes.

*Dorm closets are small and students are advised **NOT** to bring excess clothing. We urge you to leave valuables at home as the school can assume no responsibility for lost or stolen articles.*

Furniture provided: You will find these in your room--

bed	mirror	desk
bureau	wastebasket	desk chair
standing lamp	pillow	window shade(s)

You may want to add these to your room:

a rug	a small bookcase	curtains
desk lamp(NO HALOGEN)	an easy chair	a nightstand

Please be aware that student storage during the summer is limited to students who live more than two hours away and that furniture, as a rule, cannot be stored.

Students bring their own linens: twin-size sheets, pillowcases, and towels. All girls have single rooms. Most boys live in double rooms, and it would be wise to wait and see your room and meet your roommate before you purchase things for your room—coordinate—don't duplicate.

Most students also bring these items:

Phone	sewing kit
bedspread	flashlight & batteries
blanket or comforter	an extension cord/power strip
laundry bag & detergent	hangers

AN ALARM CLOCK WITH A BATTERY BACK-UP IS REQUIRED AS IT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO GET UP AND TO SCHOOL MEETING (8:00 a.m.) ON TIME—THERE ARE NO BELLS.

The following electrical appliances may be brought to school: lamps (except halogen), hair dryer, razor, iPod, stereo, headphones, fan, laptop. (As a privilege, dorm proctors are allowed to have and may bring a small refrigerator for their room.)

The following electrical appliances are not permitted and will be confiscated: halogen lamp, coffee maker, refrigerator, hot plate, television set, VCR, microwave, iron, space heater or air conditioner.

Please mark all of your possessions and clothes with a name label or an indelible marker.

In the dorm and at school, many things are shared and borrowed and it can be difficult to sort things out if they are not marked.

Laundry: Students may purchase a debit card for the laundry machines; irons and an ironing board are available in each dorm.

Luggage: Please mark all bags, trunks, and suitcases with the student's name.
